

INPACT Working Breakfast

Minutes

- **Mr. Lambert van Nistelrooij MEP**, K4I Chairman, welcomed the participants of the first INPACT working breakfast.
- **Mr. Gernot Klotz**, K4I President, summarised the INPACT state of play and Roadmap. Mr Klotz asked the K4I Members and Members of the Parliament which are the key INPACT priorities according to their interests, and called for more INPACT signatories. He explained that the latter are expected to commit for a 2-year-period and to contribute in particular to the discussions of the Working Groups. Each Working Group will focus on a specific INPACT priority and submit proposals to the Leadership Group.
- **Mr. Christian Ehler MEP** and **Mr. Lambert van Nistelrooij MEP** stated that the INPACT discussions should aim at preparing input for the mid-term review of the multiannual financial framework and the next funding period (FP9). In 2018 the European Commission will structure the new FP9 and Structural Funds programme. It will be paramount to concretise the debate and input to the European Commission in 2017.
- **Mr. Robbert Fisher**, K4I Vice-President, presented the INPACT Actions and Indicators. The implementation of the priorities will be accompanied by a “scoreboard“ bases on existing and recognised indicator sets (such as the OECD IPP, IUS,GII, GCI etc) in order to translate the high level goals of the Pact into measurable and concrete activities. Nonetheless, the progress and results of some priorities can be hardly quantified, and the collection of quantitative data will be preferred instead.
- **Prof. Jerzy Buzek MEP** and **Mr. Lambert van Nistelrooij MEP** stressed the importance of engaging EU citizens, entrepreneurs and start-ups in the innovation policy discourse.

- After a round of discussion, **Mr Roland Strauss**, K4I Managing Director, listed the 4 topics which will be addressed with the creation of INPACT Working Groups, according to the interests of the members:
 - Mid-term review of the Multiannual Financial Framework (INPACT priority VIII);
 - Information and Communication Technologies, with a special focus on 5G;
 - Better regulation for innovation (INPACT priority III);
 - Integrated and inclusive approach to innovation .

- **Mr. Lambert van Nistelrooij MEP** invited a small delegation of K4I Political Members and stakeholders to join a working breakfast meeting with **Commissioner Moedas**, which will take place on 7 June 2016 in Strasbourg.
