Subject: Call to participate in 'The Pact for Innovation' Invitation for a meeting in the EP, Brussels

Dear Minister,

The Pact for Innovation (INPACT) was launched during the Opening Ceremony of the 7th European Innovation Summit on 7 December 2015 in the European Parliament in Brussels. It was handed over to Research and Innovation Commissioner Carlos Moedas. Both, Commissioner Katainen and Commissioner Moedas welcomed the Pact during their speeches and expressed their support. At the same time the President of the Committee of the Regions Markku Markkula invited all members of the European Committee of the Regions to support this initiative.
